Resolution 1, 3-13

BE IT RESOLVED that the Berlin Borough School District Board of Education does hereby approve the 2013-2014 budget in the grand total amount of \$12,041,046 which includes a General Fund total of \$10,774,056, a Special Revenue Fund total of \$504,477., and a Debt Service Total of \$762,063; and also includes a General Fund local tax levy of \$6,463,068; and a Debt Service local tax levy of \$589,954; and BE IT RESOLVED that this budget will include a Withdrawal from Capital Reserve of \$369,000 and a Withdrawal of \$88,753 from Maintenance Reserve for partial roof replacement and repairs.
