BUDGET RESOLUTION 4-28-2021-1

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Berlin Borough Board of Education, in the County of Camden, State of New Jersey, hereby approves the 2021-2022 school district budget for submission to the Camden County Office of Education;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to acknowledge that the 2021-2022 budget, as described above, results in a General Fund tax levy of \$7,793,798 and a Debt Service Fund tax levy of \$544,500.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to acknowledge that the 2021-2022 budget, as described above, includes the use of the banked cap in the amount of \$0.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to acknowledge that the 2021-2022 budget, as described above, includes the use of the adjustment for health care costs in the amount of \$0 and the enrollment adjustment in the amount of \$0.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to acknowledge that the 2021-2022 budget, as described above, includes the transfer of \$52,000 from Maintenance Reserve to the General Fund to support Required Maintenance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to acknowledge that the 2021-2022 budget, as described above, includes the transfer of \$866,000 from Capital Reserve to the General Fund to support Capital Projects (Roof Replacement).

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

- 1. Capital Reserve Withdrawals/Deposits for Excess Costs/Other Cap. Projects (Non Referendum)
 - Capital Reserve Withdrawal Other Capital Projects
 Included in budget line 610, Withdrawal from Cap Res Excess Cost & Oth Cap Prj, is <u>\$866,000</u> for other capital project cost of <u>Berlin Community School Roof Replacement</u>. The total estimated cost for this project is <u>\$866,000</u> which represents expenditures for construction elements or projects that are in addition to the facilities efficiency standards determined by the Commissioner as necessary to achieve the core curriculum content standards.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Education had previously established a maximum amount for the pre-budget 2020-2021 as \$20,000 and the Board of Education has expended \$0 of the maximum amount of the pre-budget year to date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Education has not elected to exclude travel expenditures supported by federal funds from the maximum travel expenditure amount and the Board of Education has determined the total amount of travel expenditures supported by federal funds is \$20,000 for the pre-budget year to date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Berlin Borough Board of Education establish a maximum of \$20,000 in the general fund 2021-2022 budget for travel and travel related expenditures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that maximum dollar amounts for public relations and professional services have been established and are detailed in the appropriations section of the 2021-2022 budget.

- A. Superintendent Report: Dr. Joseph Campisi, Superintendent
 - 1. The Eastern sending district Superintendents met to discuss where we all are in our status with onsite and remote learning going into the 4th marking period.
 - 2. The updated math curriculum was sent to Eastern for review by their Math/Science department and articulation. The same will be done after adoption of the updated ELA curriculum.
 - 3. Elementary & Middle School pictures were held as well as graduation pictures for our 8th graders.
 - 4. The Administrative Team had 2 meetings with the PEER group from Rowan as we continue with our Equity





work.

- 5. The 4th marking period began and we welcomed many remote-learners back to onsite-learners.
- 6. We did have 3 remote days so over 30 of our teachers could get their second vaccination shot through a program set up by the Country Department of Education and the County Department of Health.
