RESOLUTION OF THE BERLIN BOROUGH BOARD OF EDUCATION TO APPROVE A RENEGOTIATED EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT FOR DR. JOSEPH CAMPISI AS SUPERINTENDENT FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024

WHEREAS, the Berlin Borough Board of Education ("the Board") desires to appoint Dr. Joseph Campisi ("Dr. Campisi") as Superintendent for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Board and Dr. Campisi have agreed to terms on a renegotiated employment contract for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:11-11 requires boards of education to provide public notices 30 days and 10 days, as well as a public hearing, prior to the renegotiation, extension, amendment or alteration of an employment contract with the Superintendent of Schools; and

WHEREAS, all required public notices were provided; and

WHEREAS, the Executive County Superintendent has approved the renegotiated employment contract; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the new contract was held at the Board of Education Meeting of July 14, 2021; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Berlin Borough Board of Education hereby approves a renegotiated employment contract for Dr. Joseph Campisi for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.
