Good afternoon BCS Family,

As we prepare for the reopening of the school on 1/19/2021 for onsite learners, we have a few items for your review:

Learning Environment Form	If you have not already done so, please complete the learning environment form (indicating whether your child will be onsite or remote as of the 19th). Learning Environment Form
Elementary Drop-Off	To ensure we have proper supervision with social distancing, our elementary drop off time is now 8:40 am. This will not cause any loss of instructional time.
Daily Health Form (Bus Riders)	The bus aides will continue to take temperatures and have the parents at the bus stop complete the daily health screening form.
Daily Health Form (Walkers/Bike, Car Drop-Off)	There will be a health form e-blasted out every morning at 5:00 am for you to complete. This includes the temperature check. When the children arrive, the administrators outside will check that the form has been completed. If the form has not been completed, your child will not be permitted into the building.
